## Don't Be Scared!

"Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me." – Psalm 23:4 (NIV)

Fear is a powerful emotion. It whispers doubts into our minds, paralyzes us from moving forward, and clouds our faith. Whatever it is, remember this: God is bigger than your fear. He is with you, walking beside you every step of the way. You can trust Him to lead, protect, and comfort you as you move forward in faith.
